**RULES**: Cross Country Saskatchewan Sask Cup Series Rules (2022-23 version); and FIS ICR - CCR (Canadian Competition Rules) November Precisions 2021. Paranordic categories will also be governed by WPNS Rules and Regulations for Cross Country Skiing and Biathlon, October 2021. Sanctioning: Cross Country Saskatchewan.

**CANCELLATION:** In the event that weather or trail conditions require cancellation of the race(s), the Race Committee will notify Cross Country Saskatchewan by 12PM on Friday, January 13, if the race(s) must be cancelled.

Races must be cancelled, delayed or postponed if the temperature on the coldest part of the course is below  $-20^{\circ}$ C. U12 - U8 categories must be cancelled, delayed or postponed if the temperature on the coldest part of the course is below  $-15^{\circ}$ C.

The Race Committee also reserves the right to modify race format, distances and start times before or on race day due to weather or trail conditions.

LATE REGISTRATIONS AND RACE DAY REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Payment will be cash or etransfer and will be an amount of published race fee plus 10.00 per racer. Late registrations will only be accepted by email until Saturday at 3PM by emailing <a href="mailto:buan@sasktel.net">buan@sasktel.net</a>. Unpaid fees or unsigned waivers by 9:30 AM Sunday will result in disqualification of the racer involved.

Please be careful to register in the correct gender and age categories and to enter NC race license numbers correctly so you are not charged additional fees. Do not enter text comments in the license fields.

#### **Race Licenses**

Citizen Racers (non CCS Club members) are welcome but must purchase a Nordiq Canada Supporting Member Day License at a cost of \$5 per race in addition to race registration fees, unless: 1) they live in another province or territory and already hold a valid 2022-23 Nordiq Canada license or development license, or 2) they are in the U14 and younger age categories and a member of a Nordiq Canada or CCS member club.

Competitors holding a valid Nordiq Canada licenses will receive preferential seeding (see "Draw").

**Waivers:** All competitors must sign a waiver as part of the online Zone4 registration or by 9:30 AM Sunday morning for late registrations. Competitors under 19 years of age must have this waiver signed by a parent or guardian.

**Draw:** Start order for U8 to U12 will be determined by random draw. Start order for U14 and older will be determined in two groups: 1) NC license and development license racers will be given preferential seeding with start order determined by CPL points; and 2) non-NC licensed racers and citizen racers will be grouped together in a random draw.

**Start Lists:** Will be posted at the race office (clubhouse) on Jan. 15 by 10:00AM. Start lists will be available at the Team Captains' meeting.

**Unofficial Results and Protests:** Unofficial results will be posted at the race office. The time of posting will be marked on the unofficial results. Any protests must be made to the Competition Secretary within 15 minutes of the unofficial results being posted, after which the results will be declared official.

#### **Awards**

Awards will be presented to first, second and third place finishers in each gender and age category for U20 and younger categories. The awards will be presented at or near the race office (CTSC Clubhouse) as soon as possible after the 15 minutes are over after posting the unofficial results if there are no protests or jury decisions to be made.

#### **Wax Policy**
